Are you over the age of 18 years and do not have a will?	Yes – you need a will
Are you over the age of 18 years and do not have an enduring power of attorney?	Yes – you need an enduring power of attorney
Do you have a will, but have married since the will was made?	Yes – you will need a new will (unless the will was made in contemplation of marriage)
Do you have a will, but are no longer happy with your choice of the executor named in the will?	Yes – you need a new will
Do you have a will, but are no longer happy with your choice of guardians nominated in the will?	Yes – you need a new will
Do you have a will, but are no longer happy with the way you have gifted your assets in your will?	Yes – you need a new will
Do you have a will, but are not sure if it will tax effectively provide for your family?	Yes – you need a new will
Do you have a will, but want to ensure your assets are protected for the benefit of your family members only, and not liable to be taken in the event of divorce or bankruptcy?	Yes – you need a new will
Have you misplaced your will or forgotten where it is located?	Yes – you need a new will
Do you have an enduring power of attorney, but wish to change the attorneys you have nominated?	Yes – you need a new enduring power of attorney
Is it more than 10 years since you prepared and signed your will?	Yes – you should review your will with a solicitor
Have you told your executor, friends and family where your original will and enduring power of attorney are located?	No – we highly recommend that you do this immediately.
